Although 2020 was a difficult year for everyone, we have so many reasons to be thankful.

With the support of the community and the people who donate to us, you helped to raise \$4 million dollars towards the \$5 million dollar goal for equipment in the new Intensive Care Unit (ICU). Construction for the new ICU is scheduled to start within the next month.

Another project we are seeing completed is the expansion to the Cardiac Clinics at the Nanaimo Regional General Hospital and at the Oceanside Health Centre. As well, the construction of the new Endoscopy surgical suite, used predominately for Colonoscopies, is due to be finished and ready for patients by this coming summer.

### **Endoscopy Project**

The \$1.75 Million Endoscopy Department Procedural Suite projected completion is this Summer 2021.

The new suite will increase dedicated colon screening from 3.5 days a week to 5 days, accommodating an extra 45 patients a week, and enabling up to an additional 2,340 patients to be screened each year. This will greatly reduce wait times and accommodate the growing population.

In addition to a fully equipped procedural suite, the expansion includes:

- Two new patient preparation rooms
- New patient recovery area
- Relocation of one washroom
- New storage room



### **Cardiac Project**

The \$1.93 Million Cardiac Expansion Project is Complete! We will now be able to deliver approximately 95% of pre and post-surgical and procedural cardiac care in our community, increase exams to an estimated 3,000 per year, and reduce wait times by as much as 50%.

This project will have a significant impact for thousands in Nanaimo and Oceanside who require cardiac care. We are honored to work with our generous donors and the Nanaimo Regional General Hospital to make projects like this a reality.
