Campaign to Reduce Colonoscopy Wait Times

When internal funding falls short, our mission is to ensure all departments have the medical equipment and improvements needed to provide patients with the best healthcare possible.

This year, the Hospital Foundation is raising \$1.5 million to reduce colonoscopy wait times at NRGH.

The project includes a new procedural suite for the Endoscopy Department which will be used predominantly for colonoscopies, preparation rooms and all the medical equipment.

This is a priority as colonoscopies are used to diagnose serious illnesses including Crohn's Disease, Ulcerative Colitis, Diverticulitis and Colon Cancer.

The reasons for a new procedural suite are clear. There are over 3,500 patients currently waiting up to 12 months for a colonoscopy. With the new suite, wait times will be reduced as up to 35% more procedures will be performed each year.

One in every six of us will be diagnosed with Colon Cancer in our lifetime. Colonoscopies make up 80% of all procedures and can be lifesaving. Every additional colonoscopy that can be done at NRGH is vital as we are all patients!


